Gainesville Marina on December 1, 2007 and the lake elevation is 1051.75. A year later on December 28, 2008 the lake elevation would reach the lowest point since impoundment began in the late 1950s. The walkway leading to the offices is at an extremely steep angle. *Courtesy RDC Productions* 






Nearly two years later on November 3, 2009 and the lake is above normal pool at 1071.67. The floating facilities have risen along with the lake as evident by the shoreline in the background.
